

Car Line Procedures:

Due to healthcare and safety in an attempt to reduce exposure and follow CDC guidelines for social distancing, dismissal from vehicles has changed. Dismissal for students being dropped off and picked up may be lengthier than normal. Please plan ahead to ensure you are not rushed and are able to properly follow procedures. Your patience and adherence is greatly appreciated. Please remain in the lane you have selected entering the campus. Leaving your vehicle to retrieve students is prohibited.

Lane 1 refers to the inside/closest lane to the school. Lane 2 refers to the outside lane/away from the school. Lane 2 must remain unobstructed to allow emergency access to the campus. The only times permitted to occupy lane 2 are in the morning from 8:15 - 8:35, and the afternoon 2:40 - 3:15. Vehicles found in the lane prior to the aforementioned times will be asked to move to the back of the car line. Failing to follow procedures is also a violation of **F.S.S. 316.1945 & 316.074(1)**, which may result in a Uniform Traffic Citation.

Like the world around us, our policies and procedures are subject to change. Again, we appreciate your patience as we implement these measures to ensure the health and safety of all students, staff, and your families.

Morning Car Line Procedure:

Students may be dropped off for breakfast beginning at 8:05am. Students are not to be dropped off prior to 8:15am as the lobby area is to remain clear for social distancing, and supervision is not provided. Vehicles may begin to line up in lane 1 (lane closest to the school) until 8:15am. At that time, in safe and controlled manner the car line will split into both lanes becoming "double lined". Please remain in the lane you selected entering the campus if possible. DO NOT form a double line prior to 8:15am as traffic needs to flow uninhibited. Due to healthcare and safety in an attempt to reduce

exposure and follow CDC guidelines for social distancing, dismissal from vehicles has changed. Please remain in the lane you selected entering the campus if possible.

Lane 1 vehicles (school side) will exit their vehicle after the whistle is blown and proceed directly to the entrance of the school. Once Lane 1 vehicles are cleared and dismissed, the whistle will be blown for lane 2 (outside lane) vehicles to dismiss students. The students will cross lane 1 and proceed directly to the entrance of the school. Once lane 2 is cleared they will be dismissed to make room for the next wave of vehicles. Please plan ahead to ensure you are not rushed and are able to properly follow procedures. Your patience and adherence is greatly appreciated.

Afternoon Car Line Procedure:

Vehicles may begin to line up lane 1 (closest to the school) at 2:40pm. At that time, in a safe and controlled manner the car line will split into both lanes becoming “double lined”. DO NOT form a double line prior to 2:40pm as traffic needs to flow uninhibited. Vehicles found in the lane prior to the aforementioned times will be asked to move to the back of the car line. Please remain in the lane you selected entering the campus.

Lane 1 (school side) vehicles will be called and dismissed first. Lane 2 (outside lane) vehicles will be called once lane 1 vehicles are loaded and dismissed. After which the next wave of vehicles will be pulled forward. Leaving your vehicle to retrieve students is prohibited. Please plan ahead to ensure you are not rushed and are able to properly follow procedures. Your patience and adherence is greatly appreciated.

Bad Weather Car Line Procedures:

Due to healthcare and safety in an attempt to reduce exposure and follow CDC guidelines for social distancing, dismissal from vehicles has changed. Dismissal for students being dropped off and picked up may be lengthier than normal. Please plan

ahead to ensure you are not rushed and are able to properly follow procedures. Your patience and adherence is greatly appreciated. Leaving your vehicle to retrieve students is prohibited. All vehicles will utilize lane 1 during inclement weather. This will ensure the students safety and efficiency for dismissal. Notification of “Bad Weather” dismissal procedure will be sent out in advance to allow for proper planning and adjustment in your schedule.

*NOTE: Failure to move your car when asked will result in receiving a Uniform Traffic Citation **F.S.S. 316.072 (3)** (Up to a \$500 fine AND 5 points on your Driver's License). Cell phone use while driving and in the car line is prohibited **(F.S.S 316.305)**. This measure is to ensure safety and the vehicle operator is not distracted. Failing to follow the law will result in receiving a Uniform Traffic Citation.*
